The ACI Dealing Certificate New Version Exam has been designed to cover the basic competence skills for the new entrants in dealing floors and all other financial markets roles related to foreign exchange, interest rates and commodities instruments.

- Foreign Exchange
- Rates (Money and Interest Rate Markets)
- FICC (Fixed Income, Currency and Commodities) Derivatives
- Financial Markets Applications

In each ACI Dealing Certificate New Version Exam, a candidate will be asked 70 multiple choice test questions to be answered in two hours. The computer-based exams will be offered in selected test centres all over the world. In Oman, CBFS is the Test Centre.
